The practice of Alessandro Agudio reflects on the status of the artwork and its objectual features. The artist's works play with the misunderstanding between sculpture and functional object, through the creation of "al-most-futuristic" artifacts whose forms often seem easily assimilable to the domestic environment. The obsession for details and finishes betrays an affection for proto-design, that is to say for those articles through which the do-it-yourself becomes creation, projection of suburban dreams of social redemption. However, this promise of redemption is continually neglected, since the works hide within them an idea of failure, the aware-ness of an inability to achieve a certain performativity, inviting the viewer to reflect on a contemporaneity that rests on the "surface" of the world and surrounds itself with 'things-that-are-not-as-they-seem'.
